The Club

Founded in 1956, caters for owners of, and other persons interested in, Railton, Brough Superior and Hudson, Essex, Terraplane vehicles. We are one of the oldest specialist clubs and boast an international membership, many of them of long standing. We welcome new members when they join us and start experiencing the enjoyment of driving one of these cars.

The Cars

RAILTON: Manufactured from 1933-1939 by Railton Cars Limited, Cobham, Surrey, plus a small number that were marketed in post-war years by University Motors. They were available with a variety of coach built bodies (sports tourers, drop head coupés and saloons) with the option of buying a chassis to commission individual coachbuilder's designs. Performance of these cars can only be described as impressive and in modern terms they are very practical, being able to cruise at 60mph+ with top speeds in many cases of 90mph+.

BROUGH SUPERIOR: A similar concept to the Railton. Built by George Brough of Nottingham using a similar choice of Hudson running gear, but with bodies produced by Atcherley of Birmingham. Their performance was similar to the Railton but their striking appearance could perhaps be linked to the exuberant character of their creator.

HUDSON/ESSEX/TERRAPLANE: Hudson launched their Terraplane range in 1932 and the following year the first Railton was built on this chassis. In the Twenties the Essex was a top selling car and after the war the Hudson Stepdown was another successful range. We offer membership of all Hudson products from 1909 to 1954 but we do not feel able to include the later Nash-built cars.

Club Services

The Bulletin

The life-blood of the Club, not only keeps you informed of Club news but provides details of forthcoming events, rally and meeting reports, results of historical research, technical tips, news of spares availability and details of cars and spares for sale. Published six times a year in full colour, with numerous photos, it is an award winning quality publication.

The Spares Scheme

Our excellent spares scheme (selling only to Club members) is the main reason why many people join! Original or remanufactured parts are available to keep cars in a safe and useable condition. Nearly everything that might be needed is available at reasonable cost. Other used parts are available from our large store of second-hand items. If an item is not listed the spares registrar spares@railton.org can usually help.

The Club website hosts full technical manuals both from Hudson and from the Club itself. There is also a list of the parts available from the Club.

Register of Cars

The Club maintains a register of all existing Railtons and Brough Superiors world-wide, whether owned by members or not. It also lists H.E.T. cars that are owned by U.K. members and other vehicles that are of particular interest. The register is published on the Members-only section of the Club website. The Club database also includes all Railtons and Brough Superiors that have become known to us at some time, even if they are now no more. Members can enquire about such a car by contacting the Registrar at registrar@railton.org.

The Club always has a National Meeting, usually mid-year, where there is usually a good turnout of cars.
